Eye movements in parkinsonism

Abnormal eye movements are common in movement disorders accompanying parkinsonism. The characteristic abnormal eye movements, especially involuntary eye movements, nystagmus, abnormal saccades and smooth pursuit, can help for differential diagnosis of movement disorder. So not only detailed neuro-otologic and neuro-ophthalmologic examination at bedside, but also laboratory recording may clue on parkinsonism. This session will cover the various ocular motor findings in Parkinson's disease and in the related disorders having parkinsonism.
